**BACKGROUND:** Ed. Code requires that all school districts have a Board approved budget for the next school year on or before July 1 of each year.

**BUDGET IMPLICATIONS:** The Budget for 2019-20 reflects the LCFF State funding formula that rolls several previously ear-marked categorical funding to roll into the General Fund which allow more flexibility for schools allocate funds to best reach their goals as outlined in the Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP). Included in the budget are Multi Year Projections and Balance in Excess of Minimum Reserves indicating reasons for excess reserves.
