PROPOSAL: To approve Change Order #6 in the amount of \$189.12 for the Annex Project. **BACKGROUND:** Change Order #6 consists of the following items, which were the result of either unforeseen conditions or value-added adjustments to the project.

When the purchase order was made, a contingency of \$200,000 was established. This change order will be applied to that contingency; it will be reduced by \$189.12.

Previously the board approved Change Orders #1-#5 in the amount of \$57,497.32.

Therefore, Change Order #6 will adjust the project contingency to \$142,313.56.
