A. Approve Acceptance of Work and Notice of Completion for Phase 1

PROPOSAL: To approve the Acceptance of Work and Notice of Completion for Phase 1 of the Annex project, DSA #04-118636.

BACKGROUND: Phase 1 is complete. The Notice of Completion can be filed with the County Recorder's Office to trigger a statutory timeline for any subcontractors or suppliers to file a claim against he contractor should they not have been paid for providing a product or service during the construction of phase 1. Absent filing a notice of completion, the time limit for filing a claim is 180 days.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS: Previously set via Exhibit J for Phase 1 - \$1.5 million with up to \$200,000 contingency.

B. Approve Easement with San Diego Gas & Electric Company

PROPOSAL: To approve an easement with SDG&E for \$\$

BACKGROUND: SDG&E is undergrounding utilities to eliminate Public Safety Power Shutoffs during adverse weather conditions, as part of the Strategic Undergrounding Program. SDG&E is requesting an easement to place underground lines and interconnection points, including two electrical boxes, on Spencer Valley's property, between the parking lot and the highway's right of way.

D. Approve Interdistrict Attendance Agreements for 2021-2026

PROPOSAL: To approve Interdistrict Attendance Agreements between School Districts in San Diego County for 2021-2026.

BACKGROUND: Each year districts are required to renew Interdistrict Attendance Agreements with other districts that they may be receiving students from, or sending students to, on Interdistrict transfers. The Agreements set for the terms and conditions for Interdistrict Transfer, including student conduct, attendance and academic performance. In order to facilitate the process, the Board is asked to approve the following list of possible transfer districts: Borrego Springs Unified, Julian Union, Lakeside Union, Mountain Empire Unified, Poway Unified, Ramona Unified, San Pasqual Union, Valley Center Union and Warner

Union. Agreements between districts can be approved for up to 5 years. At this time, we are asking for approval for 2021-2026.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS: Schools are funded based on Average Daily Attendance.
